We offer the following ministries:


A one-day Reconciliation Day at our conference center for your group. This will include a walking tour of our gallery of artistic display also known as the Lighthouse.

A 2-3 day workshop entitled “Healing Hearts, Transforming Nations” for deeper healing.

A 1 or 2 day retreat for couples or families at our Center dealing with such topics as communication, marriage enrichment or parent-child relationships.

Providing speakers for events and programs during the annual commemoration of the genocide

Time spent at our Center for Healing & Reconciliation and Inter-cultural Studies (CHRIST) where you can view testimonial videos, read materials about healing and reconciliation, and listen to CDs featuring messages of reconciliation. You can also consult our database or do research in the area of peace-building, healing and reconciliation.

If you want to go deeper and invest in equipping people to deal with prejudice, pain or division can invite us for a 3 to 4 day Training of Facilitators (TOF) in your location. After this training, they will be able to present and facilitate additional events on an ongoing basis.

You can also attend our International School of Reconciliation, an 18 day in-depth course that is taught in English in Rwanda or in French in Abidjan in Côte d'Ivoire. The School of Reconciliation can equip those who attend to deal with issues such as racism, prejudice, tribalism and other divisions.

Guests from outside Rwanda can also benefit from our 3 to 4 day Reconciliation tours, where we will facilitate and accompany your small group of 10-15 people in visits to genocide memorials, hearing stories from genocide victims and perpetrators, and engaging in community work

Product 2

Leadership and Organizational Development

Leadership, organizational development, meetings, retreats, trainings, consultations (live, e-mail, Online).





2 or 3 day training sessions for Church/Christian leaders in Biblical theory and practice of leadership, focusing on such topics as servant leadership, study of character, competencies, conflict resolution and team dynamics.

1-2 day consultations with executives and leadership teams on organizational matters, structural challenges and effective interaction and teambuilding



2 or 3 day Debriefing Retreat for an entire staff or organizational leadership team (after a traumatic incident, a challenging season, or when facing significant transition and change), with special focus on those who care for others or who work in dangerous situations.

Staff retreat (custom designed for your situation) around such suggested topics as motivation, conflict resolution, team dynamics, effective communication, creating a harmonious work environment, and more.

1-2 day training in cross cultural competencies and understanding for mixed race, intergenerational, multicultural, cross tribal or international missionary or ministry teams

1-2 day group mentoring, encouragement and training for young leaders

Our Center, located in Masaka, can host up to 100 non-residential, 40 residential or 20 seniors in our 2 dormitories and 12 self-contained rooms. We have a modern facility, with IT access, a meeting hall, small conferencing rooms and other amenities. We serve excellent meals and offer very affordable rates for all our services.

The fees we receive are re-invested into the life of our community and our nation. We subsidize vocational skills development for school dropouts and single women; we partner with local churches and the community to create cooperatives and provide matching grants for their development; we offer healing and reconciliation events free of charge for the immediate community and in university settings; we meet specific needs in nearby villages (such as building toilets); we protect the environment through the building of improved stoves, planting trees and crops; we provide paid internship opportunities for university graduates; and we offer low-skilled jobs at our Center to the vulnerable in our community. We also run a prison outreach ministry, providing both material and psychological support to the inmates, and assist with the reintegration of released genocide perpetrators into the community.
